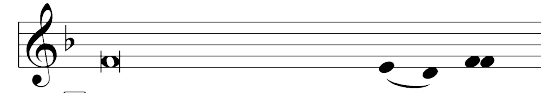

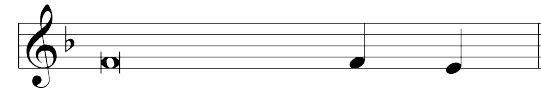

Procession enters through Narthex and stops at rear door of nave.

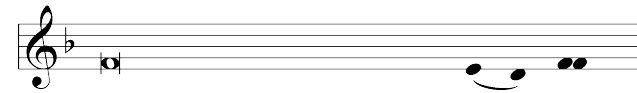


L Now is the time of God's fa - - vor;

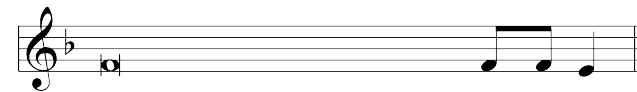


C now is the day of sal-va - - tion.

Procession moves to the center of the nave

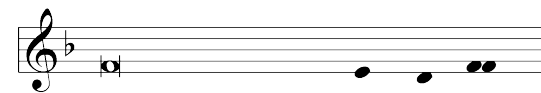


L Turn us again, O God of our sal - va - - tion,

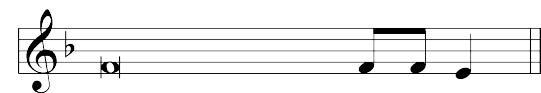


C that the light of Your face may shine on us.
