Tenebrae Service

What does Tenebrae mean? Tenebrae is a Latin word meaning darkness. The gradual extinguishing of candles and lights does more than mirror the sober meditation on the Sacrifice of our Lord Jesus. It also reminds us of the darkness that settled over the earth during Christ's crucifixion. It also reflects the words of John 1:9-11: "The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him. He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him."

The service concludes with the **Strepitus**, a loud noise, signifying the rolling of the stone into place at the door of Jesus' tomb. (Strepitus is the Latin word meaning noise).

The first Service of Easter begins with the **Return of the Light** as the lighted Paschal Candle is carried in procession into the dark nave, symbolizing the Resurrection victory of Christ, the Light of the World, as described in John 1:5: "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it."
